AGREEMENT FOR SALE OF ELECTRICAL POWER

Revised Agreement

An agreement made on 15th day

of December 2021 between The SKS Hospital
Rep: Dr Mushtaq Ahmed Dar S/o Gh. Mohd. Dar
c/o. Iqbal Haid K.P. Road Anantnag Kashmir

Hereinafter called the consumer (which term shall include the said party hereto his heirs, successors or assigns) on the one
part and government of Jammu and Kashmir represented by the Assistant Executive Engineer Electric
MARE Sub-Division Anantnag hereafter called the supplier on the other part

1. In consideration of the payment made or to be made by the consumer as hereinafter described the supplier agrees to supply the said consumer with electric energy as follows:-
- a) Locality: the power shall be supplied at consumers premises situated at Iqbal Haid K.P. Road.
- b) Date of commencement: the power supply shall commence on the 15th day of December 2021.
- c) Nature of supply: the power shall be single phase-three phase 230/400 volts or 66 KV, 50 cycles or as near it as the general distribution system shall permit.
- d) The electric current shall be supplied at the rates sanctioned or as revised from time to time by the Government.
- e) Power will be supplied from 1st April to end of September from 8 AM to 6 PM and from 1st October to end of March from 9 AM to 5 PM Subject to payment full charges prescribed for 12 hours supply.
- f) Interruption: The supplier shall /when possible give previous notice of any interruption of supply and will try to minimize its duration as far as possible.
2. The Consumer agrees:-
- a) That the charges for energy supplied shall commence on the 15th day of December 2021 whether or not he is in position to utilize any or all of it on that date.
- b) Within ten days of the completion of this agreement the consumer agrees to deposit with the supplier as security a sum equivalent to the power charges on flat rate basis for two months calculated on the makers rated input of the motor or motors to be installed by him.
The amount of the earnest money deposited with the supplier at the time to applying for power shall be taken in part payment of this security deposit.
Failure to complete this payment as above laid down may at the discretion of the supplier, entail forfeiture of the earnest money and the cancellation of this agreement either or both.
- c) To notify the supplier in writing and secure his permission of any increases /decreases he proposes to make in the machinery specified on page 4 of this agreement to be driven by the motors to be installed by him under agreement.
- d) To pay within two weeks of each month from the date bill are rendered charges for the power supply during the previous month.
- e) To observe the general rules for the regulations of the supply as issued from time to time by the supplier.
- f) To operate and maintain the whole electric plant reserved by the current supplied under the agreement to the satisfaction of the supplier.
- g) To afford every facility for the inspection of the said electrical plant by any official duly authorized on the supplier and to his and to allow free entry within his works to such official at all time during working hours.
- h) To take proper care of and to pay the monthly rent for the meter to be put up at his mill /establishment premises it is MUTUALLY AGREED that :-
1. The supplier or his authorized representative may at any time and with out notice make test of the power consumed by the plant as it is running either for the purpose of rating the motor and arriving at the amount of demand charges to be charged for or for testing purposes only.

2. In the event of delay occurring in the delivery of the consumers machinery or any part thereof which the charge for power shall commence under clause-II (A) may be altered by supplier provided as satisfied by the documentary evidence or otherwise that the delay is due to causes beyond the control of consumer and the consumer had used all possible dispatch.
3. In the event of supplier being unable supply power on the date entered in clause-II(A) then the date on which the charges for power shall commence shall be the date on which such power is first available for supply.
4. The agreement shall be in force for a period of (3) three Year from the date entered in clause-II (a).
5. If the consumer wishes to terminate this agreement at any prior date he may do so by sending one months notice in writing to supplier in which case three fourths of the security to be paid by him under clause-II (B) shall become the property of the government without deduction of any kind. But if the consumer ceases to take supply and fails to give one months notice of his intention to terminate this agreement, the whole of the security deposit with any interest occurring there on shall be forfeit to the government.
6. If the consumer at any time discontinues utilization of power temporary with the period of this agreement without any satisfactory reasons, therefore, or his installation is disconnected for not payment of dues he shall have to pay the charges at the fixed demand rate as per schedule here to for the period of disconnection also.
7. The supplier has the right to refuse to supply energy to any motor or apparatus which is declared writing by him to be improperly designed or unsafe or such as would prejudice the supply to other consumers.
8. Whilst every effort will be made to provide a continuous supply of electric power, the supplier does not accept responsibility for interruptions in the supply due for any inconvenience or loss to the consumer caused thereby. If, however, such interruption of supply shall continue for more than 48 hours from any cause whatever other than deliberate interference or obstruction of the part of the consumer, then and in that case no charge for power shall be made for any such period of continuous interruption of supply as exceed 48 hours.
9. If the consumer of any time fails to make payment as provided in clause-II(2) the supplier shall have the right to cut off the supply of energy without warning in which event the current will not be switched on again till all dues are paid in full together with a sum of Rs.1/- for reconnection charges.
10. In the event of the consumer to comply with any of the terms and provisos of the agreement the supplier shall have the right to terminate the agreement on giving ten days notice on writing and to forfeit the security deposit paid under clause-II (b) in full or in part of his description or (b) to impose a penalty upon the consumers which may extend to any sum up to the amount of the said security deposit.
11. Should the consumers work becomes inoperative for the period of exceeding three consecutive calendar months the supplier may discontinue the whole or any part of the power supplied under this agreement to other purpose.
12. At the request of the consumer made in writing more than six months before the expiry of this agreement the supplier is understood to renew the agreement upon such terms and conditions as may then appear to be equitable and may be mutually agreed upon by the parties hereto.

Rate D:

Energy supplied to all industrial consumers at three phase 400 volts with the installed capacity not exceeding 10 HP during day time shall be charged as under:-

Rs.4/- per rated HP installed P.M. Plus Energy charges at 4 P per unit for Kashmir 6 p. per unit for Jammu.

The meter hire shall be Rs.4/- per month

Note:- When installation are not metered due to non availability of meters the flat rate charges shall be Rs. and Rs. 12/- per rated H.P per month for day supply for Kashmir and Jammu respectively.

Rate E:

Energy to industrial consumers having motors rated capacity exceeding 10 HP shall be supplied at H pressure and the consumer shall provide his own transformer and LT System.

Rs.4/- per month per rated HP plus energy charges at 25 P and 4 P per unit measured on HT side for Kashmir and Jammu respectively provide the lighting consumption for light fans etc. does not exceeds 5% the norm under D for lighting and fan etc. Shall hold for Industries where power is supplied on LT the same rate under D shall be applicable.

The Meter hire shall be Rs. 10/- Per Month.

It shall however be optional for Industries to choose either for the two systems.

Note:

- The consumer shall have no objection of low voltage.
- The Department reserves the right to cut off supply at time on immediate notice when the load condition and voltage condition make it necessary to do so.
- The Consumer cannot sell or sublet the mill within the term of agreement and without the permission Department.

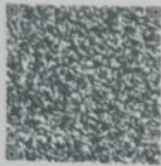

Whereas the Kashmir Health Care Systems [KHCS] has setup a common bio-medical waste treatment disposal facility (CBWTF) at 4154, IGC Lassipora Pulwama Kashmir and has obtained authorization/consented from state Pollution control Board (JKSPCB) for collection transportation treatment and disposal of Bio medical waste (BMW) generated by the health care establishment (Hospital, Nursing home, Blood Bank, OPD Clinic, pathological Lab, Diagnostic center etc)

Whereas Kashmir Health Care Systems offers to provide services to the generator on user pace principal for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of Bio Medical waste at the prevalent rates.

Whereas the generator is a hospital OPD / pathological laboratory /Diagnostic center and agrees to avail the services being provided by Kashmir Health Care Systems with the terms and conditions as listed on succeeding Paras. **The agreement is valid for one year from the date of effect.**

RESPONSIBILITIES OF KASHMIR HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS

1. Kashmir health care Systems shall meet all the rules and regulations of the Pollution Control board and the Acts governing the waste management.
2. Kashmir health Care Systems alone is liable for any violations of the environments protection Act 1985 and the relevant rules made there under after the collection of BMW from the generator unit as per the agreement terms and conditions.
3. Kashmir health Systems shall daily collect BMWs from the generator
4. In case Kashmir health care Systems fails to collect the BMW within 48 hours of the designated time due to any reason the generator shall inform Kashmir Health Care Systems at IGC Lassipora Pulwama who will ensure strictly collection the BMW with next 48 hrs, KASHMIR HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS shall be solely responsible for the consequences and KHCS office shall maintain a register for such complaints filed by the generator.
5. Other complaints if any shall also be made to Kashmir Health Care Systems office at IGC Lassipora office/Karan Nagar by the generator, Kashmir Health Care Systems office promises to attend to all complaints within the shortest possible time.
6. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall collect the segregated BMW from the identified common waste collection site in the premises of generator.
7. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall provide assistance to finalize the pick-up location to the generator.
8. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall transport segregated waste in a closed container vehicle to its treatment plant.
9. Kashmir Health Care Systems office will provide the initial training about segregation of BMW in colored code plastic bags and method of collection of BMW shall be provided at no extra cost.
10. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall schedule the timing for the collection of waste in consultations with generator.

11. Kashmir Health Care Systems office promises to keep high standard of pollution control and shall update its equipment facility as and when asked by the State and central Pollution Control Board.
12. Kashmir Health Care Systems office will not be liable for environmental protection Act 1986 or any similar regulations setup by the SPCB govt bodies in the event the generator violates any of the terms and conditions.
13. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall be responsible for appropriate treatment and shedding of disinfected waste at the centralized facility as per schedule 1st of BMW rules 1998.
14. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall also undertake testing or treated waste to ensure the safety of the environment.
15. Kashmir Health Care Systems office shall be responsible for the disposal of treated waste into secured landfills or in recycling plants as applicable.

Responsibilities of the Generator

1. Generator shall segregate the waste at the point of generation in accordance with the BMW (M&H) rules 1998 and in accordance with the standards prescribed there under.
2. That the generator shall collect the segregated BMW in non chlorinated plastic bags as a stipulated by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) norms.
3. **In no case un-segregated waste will be lifted** by the service provider, Generator should take all steps to stop the un-healthy practice which otherwise will force the service provider to stop the service within a notice of 10 days under an intimation to State Pollution Control Board.
4. All consumable like bags, needle, cutters, disinfectants etc shall be procured by the generator at its own cost, Kashmir Health Care Systems office is committed to supply the same at reasonable rates.
5. The bag used for collecting solid materials, placenta, amputated body parts etc required to be incinerated) shall be non-Chlorinated plastic bags.
6. All the bags shall be sealed highly by the generator Kashmir health care Systems will collect the sealed bags only from the designated point in the premises of the GENERATOR.
7. The generator shall disinfect the sharps and mutilate them and hand them over in puncture proof containers to Kashmir health care Systems office.
8. The generator shall take all the steps to ensure that the waste is handle without adverse effect to human health and environment.
